ThriveWell Cancer Foundation funded four cutting-edge research grants during 2013. The title of the funded projects are as follows: Using Mobile Technology to Enhance Supportive Care for Breast Cancer; Establishment, characterization and in vivo evaluation of patient derived models of non-alcoholic steatohepatitis (NASH) association hepatocellular carcinoma; MicroRNA's: Safe and Potent Therapeutic Molecules for Treating Drug Resistant Breast Cancers; DNA Extraction & Banking of Tumor and Normal Paired Specimens to Support Whole Genome Sequencing and Clinical Outcome - San Antonio 1000 Cancer Genome Project.

During 2013, Thrivewell Cancer Foundation provided transportation services to 75 cancer patients and financial assistance to 145 cancer patients helping offset the costs associated with their treatment.

Deriving Inspiration & Vitality Program (DIVA) provides exercise, nutrition and wellness classes to breast cancer patients and survivors in San Antonio and Bexar County. Research shows that women who exercise and follow a low-fat diet and adhere to their recommended hormonal or chemotherapy, have a reduction in breast cancer mortality by up to 50%. As of December 31, 2013, more than 800 breast cancer patients and survivors were a part of the DIVA program.
